Despite being in a pandemic, several of my sisters in faith have continued with a Bible study, safely. Recently the group studied through a book by author James W. Moore, "When the World Takes the Wind Out of Your Sales." Each chapter offers help for the different challenges we face in life. One of the chapters speaks about spreading your problems before the Lord. This chapter explains there are challenges that test our faith and difficult times make the future seem uncertain.
